We are going to be holding a horse knowledge test during the show, all contestants are eligible to compete, & there will be a \$4.00 entry fee. There will be a written test and 10 stations (where you will need to identify tack, feed, etc.). Trophies (No Buckle) will be awarded to the 1st through 6th place contestants in BOTH age groups (**7-9 and 10-12**), so be sure to enter and test your horse knowledge! The test will be available to be taken from 7:30 to 3:00. Results will be announced by end of show.
